

Highly selective B-complex formula for increased vitamins demand

Composition

Each ampoule contains the following Vitamins:

B 1 (Thiamine Mononitrate)...... 10 mg.

B 6 (Pyridoxine Hydrochloride)...... 4 mg.

Properties

Each B-com® ampoule provides concentrations of vitamin B-complex members (ranges 100 - 666 % of RDA) available in a single injectable dose.

of action...

Indications

B-com® is indicated in conditions characterized by increased demand of the water-soluble B-complex vitamins e.g. during pregnancy and lactation, prophylaxis and treatment of vitamin deficiency diseases e.g. beriberi, pityriasis alba, glossitis, and stomatitis loss of appetite, and in gastrointestinal disorders interfering with intake or absorption of water-soluble vitamins . It is also useful in the nutritional management of patients during prolonged convalescence associated with major surgery. It is indicated for stressful conditions, after prolonged treatment with antibiotics and diuretics , pre and post operative cases, , diabetes, wasting diseases, high catabolic loss conditions e.g., fractures, severe infections & burns, and some psychological disorders.

Precautions

B-com® should be taken cautiously in patients with previous history of allergy to any

B-complex member.

As with all B.complex vitamins, repeated I.V. and possibly I.M. injections may in rare cases give rise to anaphylactoid reactions.

Dosage The usual dosage is one **B-com**® ampoule daily or every other day, or as prescribed by the physician. It is taken I.M. / I.V. injection or I.V. added to a drip infusion.

2 ml ampoules in packs of 3 or 6 ampoules
